Facilities

Newly refurbished courts now available at QE Wimborne.

Budmouth outdoor courts are of poor quality and the S&W Dorset league are continuing to resolve the issues and/or seek alternative courts. This has proven to be a lengthy and complicated process. Matched funding has been approved from England Netball to support the transition of the league to the Hockey pitch (to provide 6 floodlit netball courts). Discussions continue regarding the practicality of the venue, particularly around parking.

Sport England – Tier 1 Governance
