1 Accounting policies

These financial statements have been prepared for the members of the Dorset County Netball Association ("Netball Dorset") in accordance with section 9.3 of the Netball Dorset Constitution. These financial statements have been prepared on a cash basis and cover the year from 1 May 2022 to 30 April 2023. Funding decisions are shown separately from expenditure on game development.

2 Membership fees

Membership fees for players are collected by England Netball and remitted to Netball Dorset. The fees for 2022/23 per player were £8.50 for over-18s, £6.05 for 18s and under, £3.60 for 14s and under and £0 for 11s and under. (2021/22: £8.10 for over-18s, £5.75 for 18s and under and £3.40 for 14s and under).

3 Funding

The Board provides funding for the benefit of netball in Dorset from its own funds. In the past year the following funding was provided.
